As always, the tour begins at the Historical Society of Hammonton's Museum Located at 333 School Lane.

Advanced tickets are \$25.00. The ticket price includes a holiday exhibit at the Historical Society Museum, a spaghetti dinner at the American Legion on Egg Harbor Road, a tour of houses of worship and meeting houses downtown, and tours of participating homes in the neighborhood between Egg Harbor Road and Tilton Street (including Victorian homes on Third Street), and of course, letters to Santa! At the end of the evening, all are welcome back to the American Legion for coffee, light desserts and caroling with Father Christmas. The evening will be filled with music, surprises and much more. The museum will open promptly at 4:30pm and will close at 8:30pm on the day of the tour and will allow tour participants to visit tour sites until 9:30pm.
