Geoff an HHS graduate ,now living in Annapolis Maryland , recently won a contest sponsored by Rotary and became an adopted member of the Rotary Club of Naples where he and his wife visited many cousins for the first time.

Geoff was rewarded by Rotary for his winning article on the Continisio family. He will tell the story of his great grandfather who arrived in America in 1900, where he was employed as a tailor in New York City. His wife followed in 1905 and when they were married in 1910 moved to Philadelphia.

In 1920 his best friend, Angelo Prestipino, invited him to visit Hammonton, home to many Italian immigrants. There, they started a business, C&P Coat Factory.

With a growing family in 1925, they moved to Hammonton .There, their children, Mary , Ralph, Aurelio(Lobby), Joseph, Nicholas became leaders in the community .Achille and Acursia lived a modest lifestyle and their greatest accomplishments were they were always able to provide for their children. Accursia dedicated her life to cooking in the kitchen and Achille to that they were well cared for. Some of the best family gatherings haves been shared at the dinner table by indulging in family owned recipes and telling how fortunate we are to have all we need in America at the sacrifice of my great grandparents.
